SHURLEY GRAMMAR

Dates: July 6-10 (Session A)

July 13-17 (Session B)

Students will use a mix of drills, songs and games to learn the 8 parts of speech. Students will classify sentences and gain strong skills in identifying the parts of speech in sentences. Excellent preparation for students who need to “brush up” on language skills. For students in grades 1-5. *One-week course – may also be taken as a two-week course; subject matter will be tailored to students’ needs.*

SAXON MATH

Sharpen your math skills! Practice basic calculations in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to improve both speed and accuracy. Math topics covered include fractions, mixed numbers, Roman numerals, positive and negative numbers, mean and median, polygons, angles and decimals. All concepts will be introduced and practiced. More advanced students will go on to work on higher concepts. Open to students in grades 1-4. *One-week course – may also be taken as a two-week course; subject matter will be tailored to students’ needs.*

LATIN PREP A

Students will use a mix of drills, songs, and games to build a foundation of Latin grammar and translation. Excellent preparation for beginners in grades 3-8, especially those entering dialectic grades at Providence. *Two-week course.*

LATIN PREP B

Similar to Prep A in format, Prep B takes the student deeper into Latin grammar (e.g., 3rd conjugation verbs and 3rd declension nouns) and covers some nuances of translating original ancient and medieval texts. Recommended for students who have studied Latin for one or two years.
